

## *The Maryida Mosby Travel Scholarship--*

is awarded in memory of *Maryida Mosby*, a former social studies teacher at George Washington High School in the Charleston, WV area.

For fourteen years she took groups of students on tours to study history first hand. Her travels began in the United States, spread to Hawaii and expanded to include four trips to Europe.

It was her dream to promote better world understanding. As a social studies teacher for thirty-eight years in Kanawha County, she found the time to be active in many organizations related to her work. She was:

- ❖ co-author of several textbooks and curricula in the social studies field.
- ❖ listed in *Who's Who in American Education* and *Who's Who in American Women*
- ❖ a recipient of the Freedom Award from the Freedom Foundation at Valley Forge, PA
- ❖ Grand Vice-President of the AΔK Northeast Region
- ❖ Grand Historian of AΔK International Sorority
- ❖ AΔK State President of West Virginia
- ❖ recognized throughout many educational circles

### *Guidelines for the Maryida Mosby Travel Scholarship*

The \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a tenth or eleventh grade student in an accredited West Virginia high school for educational travel only, either in the United States or a foreign country. **Dec. 12, 2017**

Return completed applications and requested materials by **specified deadline date** to the counselor or principal.

Counselors or principals should return applications and materials to the local AΔK chapter by deadline date.

Applications will be screened and the winner will be required to attend the WV AΔK convention in the spring.

The recipient shall participate in as many cultural and educational experiences as possible and give a brief synopsis at the conclusion of his/her travels.

The recipient shall share knowledge gained from the experience with schools, civic organizations, and AΔK chapters.

The application packet **must** contain:

- Completed application form
- Sealed letters of reference to accompany the application. **Three** letters of reference (**one** from a teacher, a counselor, or a principal, and two from business or professional people, other than relatives).
- An official academic transcript.
- A recent (non-returnable) photograph with completed application.

To: Student Applicant

The *Maryida Mosby Travel Scholarship* in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to an outstanding West Virginia tenth or eleventh grade student during the West Virginia Alpha Delta Kappa State Convention in April 2018. The scholarship is provided in memory of Maryida Mosby, a former social studies teacher and Alpha Delta Kappa member and state president. She was committed to improving world understanding through travel.

**Scholarship Guidelines:**

1. The Maryida Mosby Travel Scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a tenth or eleventh grade student in an accredited West Virginia High School for educational travel only, either in the United States or a foreign country.
2. The procedure to be followed by the applicant shall be:
  - a. Complete the application form
    1. Secure three letters of reference (one from a teacher, counselor, or principal and two from business or professional people, other than relatives).
    2. Include these sealed letters of reference with the application.
    3. Secure and include an academic transcript with the application.
    4. Include a recent photograph (that cannot be returned) with the application.
  - b. Return the completed application form and all items listed above to the counselor or principal by **December 12, 2017.**
3. Counselors or principal shall return the completed application and requested materials (listed in part a) to the local Alpha Delta Kappa Chapter President by **December 19, 2017.**
4. The local chapter will screen completed applications and determine the most qualified one. This application will be **signed and sent** by the chapter president to the chairman of the Maryida Mosby Travel Scholarship chairman so that it is received by **January 19, 2018.**
5. The application will be screened and the winner will be selected by the Maryida Mosby Travel Scholarship Committee.
6. The winner will be required to attend the Saturday luncheon at the West Virginia Alpha Delta Kappa State Convention on **April 21, 2018** at Pullman Plaza Hotel, Huntington WV. The scholarship will be presented at this time. Absence from the presentation will result in the forfeiture of the award. The exception of this condition would be in the case of death or serious illness.
7. The scholarship recipient shall participate in as many cultural and educational experiences as possible during his/her scholarship year.
8. The recipient shall submit a brief summary at the conclusion of his/her travels.
9. Experiences gained shall be shared by the scholarship recipient with schools, civic organizations, and Alpha Delta Kappa Chapters.
