- On a separate sheet of paper write a one-page essay that will tell us something about you that may distinguish you from other applicants. The essay should be typed {14 font} and double spaced. In the essay include the following:
  - Primary interests in and out of school.
  - How have you given back to your school/community?
  - What are your greatest strengths?
  - What are your goals in life and how will you achieve them?
- Identify any other scholarships {including the Promise Scholarship} or financial aid you anticipate receiving.
